A RESOLUTION ENTERING INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH CENTRAL CONTRA COSTA TRANSIT AUTHORITY FOR THE PURCHASE OF A TRANSIT BUS.

WHEREAS, the City of Albany, designated operator of the Linn-Benton Loop, desires to purchase a transit bus on the contract Central Contra Costa Transit Authority has negotiated with Gillig Corporation; and

WHEREAS, Central Contra Costa Transit Authority consents to this assignment; and

WHEREAS, Gillig Corporation also agrees to the assignment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany accepts the intergovernmental agreement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, authorizes the City Manager to execute the agreement and conditions for acceptance.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into as of this 7th day of November, 2001, by and between The City of Albany, Oregon (hereinafter referred to "CITY OF ALBANY") and CENTRAL CONTRA COSTA TRANSIT AUTHORITY, a joint powers agency created under California Government Code Section 6500 et seq. (hereinafter referred to as "CCCTA").

WITNESSES THAT:

WHEREAS, CITY OF ALBANY and CCCTA are each governmental entities and are authorized to contract with other governmental entities; and

WHEREAS, CCCTA has entered into a bus procurement contract entitled "Bus Procurement Project," Contract No. 02-MA-001, dated October 25, 2001 (hereinafter referred to as "the Contract"), with Gillig Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "Gillig"); and

WHEREAS, CITY OF ALBANY is desirous of acquiring coaches from Gillig under the Contract; and

WHEREAS, subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, CCCTA will consent to CITY OF ALBANY acquiring one (1) 35-foot and one (1) 40-foot Phantom coach under the terms and conditions of the Contract and under the terms and conditions of this Intergovernmental Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms, conditions and covenants contained herein, CITY OF ALBANY and CCCTA agree as follows:

- 1. CONSENT TO ASSIGNMENT. CCCTA consents to CITY OF ALBANY's purchase of up to one (1) 35-foot and one (1) 40-foot Phantom coaches in year two of the Contract term under and pursuant to the Contract, and CCCTA will assign to CITY OF ALBANY all CCCTA rights under the Contract in connection with the purchase of said two (2) coaches from Gillig.
- 2. CONDITIONS OF ASSIGNMENT. CITY OF ALBANY shall negotiate and contract directly with Gillig for the purchase of the said two (2) coaches, pursuant to CCCTA's Contract.
- 3. WAIVER AND RELEASE. This Agreement is conditioned upon the execution of the attached Waiver and Release by Gillig, and the delivery of the Waiver and Release to CCCTA.
- 4. INDEMNIFICATION. CITY OF ALBANY shall defend, indemnify and hold CCCTA harmless from and against any liability resulting from CITY OF ALBANY's purchase and use of the coaches pursuant to the CCCTA Contract.

- 5. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties hereto, and all other representations or statements heretofore made, verbal or written, are merged herein. This agreement may only be amended in writing, executed by duly authorized representatives of the parties hereto.
- 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Agreement shall be effective upon being fully executed by both CITY OF ALBANY and CCCTA, and the attached Waiver and Release has been executed by Gillig. This Agreement shall remain in effect through the 25th day of October 2006, unless extended or sooner terminated by the mutual agreement of the parties hereto.
- 7. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed this Agreement as of the day and year first hereinabove written.

NOW, THEREFORE, Gillig hereby declares and states as follows:

This Waiver and Release is executed by Gillig for the benefit of CCCTA in connection with, and Gillig hereby consents to, the purchase of the Coaches by CITY OF ALBANY pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Contract and the contract currently being negotiated by Gillig and CITY OF ALBANY.

Gillig hereby waives and releases any and all claims it may have against CCCTA with respect to any and all obligations of CITY OF ALBANY under the contract Gillig is negotiating with CITY OF ALBANY for the purchase of the Coaches and pursuant to the Contract between Gillig and CCCTA.


