RESOLUTION NO. 4689

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON PROVIDING FOR THE AUTHORIZATION, ISSUANCE, SALE, **DELIVERY** OF ITS LIMITED EXECUTION AND IMPROVEMENT BONDS, SERIES 2002, IN AN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$750,000 FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE CITY; DESIGNATING AN REPRESENTATIVE; **AUTHORIZING** THE AUTHORIZED BOND PURCHASE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF AGREEMENT: AND RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, the City of Albany, Oregon (the "City") has caused certain sewer, water, paving of streets, curbs, sidewalks and storm drainage improvements (collectively, the "Project"), to be constructed within the following Local Improvement Districts known as:

SS-95-2, Alandale Sanitary Sewer Local Improvement District

ST-94-9, Hickory Street Reconstruction and Off-Site Storm Drainage Local Improvement District

ST-95-5, Marion Street Local Improvement District

ST-95-7, Marion Street Local Improvement District

SS-98-1, Riverside Drive Sanitary Sewer Local Improvement District

SS-91-3/WL-91-5, Timber Street Sewer and Water Line Extensions Local Improvement District

SS-01-09, 12th Avenue Sanitary Sewer Extension Local Improvement District

ST-97-04, Lehigh/Riderwood Access Local Improvement District

(hereinafter, the "Districts"). The City has assessed the costs of such improvements upon the lots, blocks and parts thereof, and parcels of real property being directly benefited by these local improvements, in accordance with the provisions of the Charter, the Code of the City of Albany, Oregon (the "Municipal Code") and applicable Oregon law; and

WHEREAS, applications to pay the assessments in installments as provided by Section 15.04.100 of the Municipal Code and Oregon Revised Statutes Sections 223.205 and 223.210 to 223.295, inclusive, have been duly filed by the owners of the benefited properties. Each application provides that the property owner agrees to pay the assessment in five (5), ten (10), fifteen (15) or twenty (20) years in semi-annual or monthly installments, together with interest at the rate prescribed by the City, billing charges and a proportionate part of the cost of issuing the bonds and administering the assessment program. Each application states that the applicant and property owner waives all irregularities or defects, jurisdictional or otherwise, in the proceedings to cause the improvements to be constructed for which the assessment is levied and in apportionment of the costs thereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. BONDS AUTHORIZED. The City Council authorizes the issuance, negotiated sale, execution and delivery of Limited Tax Improvement Bonds, Series 2002 (the "Bonds") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$750,000. The proceeds of the Bonds shall be used for the purpose of financing or reimbursing the costs of the construction of public improvements known as the Project and to pay costs of issuance of the Bonds. Assessments and charges against the benefited properties in the Districts for the costs of the local public improvements have been duly levied upon the real property

directly benefited thereby and such assessments and charges have been duly docketed in the lien docket of the City and are liens against the benefited properties. The owners of the benefited properties affected by such assessments have heretofore filed in writing their applications to pay their assessments in installments as provided by law. The owners of the benefited properties who filed such applications and the amounts remaining unpaid on the applications are as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto. The Bonds shall mature no later than December 31, 2022. The true interest cost of the Bonds shall not exceed 6.50% per annum. The remaining terms for the issuance of the Bonds shall be established as provided in Section 9 of this Resolution.

- <u>Section 2. AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE</u>. The City authorizes the City Manager, the Assistant City Manager, or their designee (the "Authorized Representative"), to act on behalf of the City and determine the terms of the Bonds as specified in Section 9.
- Section 3. SECURITY. The City pledges to payment of the Bonds its full faith and credit, the assessment installment payments received by the City from the owners of the benefited properties in the Districts who have filed applications to pay the amount of the assessments and charges in installments, the net proceeds received from any liquidation, due to foreclosure, of properties subject to the lien securing such assessment installment payments or the settlement of such foreclosures, the unexpended proceeds of the Bonds and all legally available funds of the City (the "Security"). The City also covenants to levy a tax on all taxable property within the City, within the limitations of Sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution, which together with the Security shall be sufficient to pay the principal and interest on the Bonds. Pursuant to ORS 288.594, the pledge made by this Section 3 shall immediately be subject to the lien of such pledge without any physical delivery or further act, and the lien of the pledge shall be superior to all other claims and liens whatsoever (except for the lien of the Bonds) to the fullest extent permitted by ORS 288.594(2).
- <u>Section 4. FORM OF BONDS</u>. The Bonds shall be prepared in substantially the form approved by the Authorized Representative. The Bonds may be printed or typewritten, and may be issued as one or more temporary Bonds which shall be exchangeable for definitive Bonds when definitive Bonds are available. The Bonds shall be prepared by Bond Counsel.
- <u>Section 5. EXECUTION OF BONDS</u>. The Bonds shall be executed on behalf of the City with the facsimile signature of the Mayor and attested by the manual signature of the Finance Director.
- <u>Section 6. OPTIONAL AND MANDATORY REDEMPTION.</u> The Bonds may be subject to optional redemption and mandatory redemption prior to maturity as determined by the Authorized Representative pursuant to Section 9 hereof.
- Section 7. TAX COVENANTS. The City covenants to use the proceeds of the Bonds, and the facilities financed with the Bonds, and to otherwise comply with the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), so that interest paid on the Bonds will not be includable in gross income of the Bondowners for federal income tax purposes. The City specifically covenants:
- (1) to comply with the "arbitrage" provisions of Section 148 of the Code, and to pay any rebates to the United States on the gross proceeds of the Bonds; and
- (2) to operate the facilities financed with the proceeds of the Bonds so that the Bonds are not "private activity bonds" under Section 141 of the Code; and
 - (3) to comply with all reporting requirements.

The Authorized Representative may enter into covenants on behalf of the City to protect the tax-exempt status of the Bonds.

Section 8. DESIGNATION OF BONDS AS QUALIFIED TAX-EXEMPT OBLIGATIONS. The City designates the Bonds as "qualified tax-exempt obligations" pursuant to Section 265(b)(3) of the Code. The City and all subordinate entities do not reasonably expect to issue more than \$10,000,000 of tax-exempt obligations during the 2002 calendar year.

Section 9. DELEGATION FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF TERMS AND SALE OF THE BONDS. The Authorized Representative is hereby authorized pursuant to ORS 288.520(4) to:

- (1) obtain proposals from qualified purchasers to purchase the Bonds;
- (2) establish the principal and interest payment dates, principal amounts, optional and mandatory redemption provisions, if any, interest rates, and denominations and all other terms for the Bonds;
- (3) select the best proposal to purchase the Bonds and to negotiate the terms under which the Bonds shall be sold; enter into a bond purchase agreement for the sale of the Bonds which incorporates those terms; and execute and deliver such bond purchase agreement;
 - (4) approve, execute and deliver the Bond closing documents and certificates;
- (5) enter into covenants regarding the use of the proceeds of the Bonds and the projects financed with the proceeds of the Bonds, to maintain the tax-exempt status of the Bonds; and
- (6) execute and deliver a certificate specifying the action taken pursuant to this Section 9, and any other certificates, documents or agreements that the Authorized Representative determines are desirable to issue, sell and deliver the Bonds in accordance with this Resolution.
- <u>Section 10. ESTABLISHMENT OF FUNDS</u>. The Authorized Representative may create such funds and accounts into which the proceeds of the Bonds shall be deposited, as necessary to pay, secure or maintain the tax-exempt status of the Bonds.
- Section 11. DEFEASANCE OF BONDS. The City may defease the Bonds by setting aside, with a duly appointed escrow agent, in a special escrow account irrevocably pledged to the payment of the Bonds to be defeased, cash or direct obligations of the United States in an amount which, in the opinion of an independent certified public accountant, is sufficient without reinvestment to pay all principal and interest on the defeased Bonds until their maturity date or any earlier redemption date. Bonds which have been defeased pursuant to this Section shall be deemed paid and no longer outstanding, and shall cease to be entitled to any lien, benefit or security under this Resolution except the right to receive payment from such special escrow account.
- Section 12. DESIGNATION OF BOND COUNSEL AND FINANCIAL ADVISOR. The City appoints Ater Wynne LLP, to serve as Bond Counsel for the Bonds and Regional Financial Advisors, Inc. to serve as Financial Advisor to the City for the Bonds.
- Section 13. RESOLUTION TO CONSTITUTE CONTRACT. In consideration of the purchase and acceptance of any or all of the Bonds by those who shall own the same from time to time (the "Bondowners"), the provisions of this Resolution shall be part of the contract of the City with the Bondowners and shall be deemed to be and shall constitute a contract between the City and the

Bondowners. The covenants, pledges, representations and warranties contained in this Resolution or in the closing documents executed in connection with the Bonds, including without limitation the City's covenants and pledges contained in Section 3 hereof, and the other covenants and agreements herein set forth to be performed by or on behalf of the City shall be contracts for the equal benefit, protection and security of the Bondowners, all of which shall be of equal rank without preference, priority or distinction of any of such Bonds over any other thereof, except as expressly provided in or pursuant to this Resolution.

<u>Section 14. EFFECTIVE DATE OF RESOLUTION</u>. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council.
