EASEMENT FOR BIKE PATH

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 26 day of September, 2002, by and between the CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, a municipal corporation (hereinafter "City") and RICHARD A BOUDREAU and ALMA K. BOUDREAU (hereinafter "Boudreaus"),

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Boudreaus previously granted City an Easement for Bike Path on May 7, 1996, which Easement was recorded at Vol. 0806, page 123, of Linn County Deed Records, and,

WHEREAS, City and Boudreaus have agreed on a new and different easement location, and,

WHEREAS, Boudreaus have contemporaneously granted City an Easement for a bike path at a different location across their property; and,

WHEREAS, in consideration of the new Easement, the City wishes to reconvey the previous Easement to Boudreaus;

AGREEMENT:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein, the parties agree as follows

- 1 Incorporation of Recitals. The Recitals set forth above are incorporated into this instrument
- 2. Boudreaus do hereby grant, bargain and sell unto the City over and upon the real property described in *Exhibit "1"* attached hereto, and by this reference incorporated herein, an easement to construct, maintain, and use, a pedestrian bicycle path for public recreational purposes The location of this Easement shall be as set forth in *Exhibit "2"* attached hereto, and by this reference incorporated herein.
- The City shall have rights of ingress and egress to and from said real property, including the right from time to time to cut, trim and remove trees, brush, and overhanging branches and other obstructions necessary for use of the property as a public bike and pedestrian path and shall have the enjoyment, operation and maintenance of the easement granted herein and all rights and privileges incident thereto.
- Except as to the rights granted herein, Boudreaus shall have the full use and control of the above-described real property.
- 5 The Easement described hereinabove shall continue in perpetuity.

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6. This Easement shall bind and inure to the benefit of, as circumstances require, not only to the immediate parties hereto, but also to their heirs, administrators, and successors-in-interest as well


