EASEMENT FOR BIKE PATH

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 1 day of April, 1996, by and between RICHARD A. BOUDREAU and ALMA K. BOUDREAU, hereinafter called "Boudreau;" and the CITY OF ALBANY, LINN COUNTY, OREGON, a municipal corporation, hereinafter called "City":

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Boudresu is the record owner of the real property located in Albany, Linn County, Oregon, legally described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, Boudress has the unrestricted right to great the exernent hereinafter described relative to said

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the premises and in consideration of no dollars and other valuable consideration given and paid by the City, receipt of which is hereby acknowledge by Boudresu, they agree as fallows:

- 1. Boudreau does hereby grant, assign and set over unto the City over and upon the property abovedescribed the right to use the same as and for a pedestrian and blke path to be used by the citizens and general public in the City of Albany.
- 2. The City shall have all rights of ingress and egress to and from said real property, including the right from time-to-time, except as hereinafter provided, to cut, trim and remove trees, bruth and overhanging branches and other obstructions necessary for use of the property as a public blike path and shall have the enjoyment, operation and maintenance of the easement herein granted and all rights and privileges incident thereto.
- 3. Except as to the rights herein granted Boudreau shall have the full use and control of the abovedescribed real property.
- 4. The City does hereby agree to hold Boudreau harmless from any and all claims of third-parties arising from the use of the property as and for a bike path.
- . 5. The easement described hereinabove shall continue in perpetuity.
- 6. This agreement shall bind and inure to the benefit of, as the circumstances require, not only the immediate parties hereto, but also to their heirs, executors, administrators and successors in interest as well.

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
