RESOLUTION NO. 4770

A RESOLUTION TO PROCEED WITH A SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM GRANT TO REPLACE ONE ALBANY TRANSIT SYSTEM BUS.

WHEREAS, the City of Albany desires to purchase a replacement transit bus for the Albany Transit System; and

WHEREAS, Albany Transit System has completed a preliminary Surface Transportation Program grant application and received authorization to proceed from the Oregon Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the grant will provide 80 percent of the estimated purchase price of a replacement bus (\$184,000) and the required 20 percent match (\$46,000) is accrued in the Equipment Replacement Fund (09-482); and

WHEREAS, it is cost effective to piggyback the purchase on another public transit agency's contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Albany authorizes staff to proceed with the Surface Transportation Program grant in the amount of \$184,000 and further authorizes staff to seek a public transit agency bus contract upon which to piggyback; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
