

RESOLUTION NO. 4933

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION GRANT FROM THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE ALBANY PARATRANSIT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Transportation Network, via the Oregon Department of Transportation, has offered the City of Albany a grant in the amount of \$44,000 for replacement of two sedans for the Albany Paratransit and Call-A-Ride Program; and

WHEREAS, the City has grant funds available through the Linn County Special Transportation Funds Grant (STF) (Resolution No. 4216) to provide approximately \$4,600 of matching funds for replacement of one Call-A-Ride sedan during each of two fiscal years, FY 2003-04 and FY 2004-05; and


WHEREAS, the replacement of the sedan will improve the quality of transportation and continue to allow the Call-A-Ride program to provide reliable and safe transportation to all elderly and American Disability Act-eligible citizens of Albany; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany accepts this Community Transportation Grant in the amount of \$44,000 for replacement of two sedans used by the Call-A-Ride Program and Albany Paratransit.


