A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A FEDERAL LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT FROM THE OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW PLAYGROUND AT TAKENA PARK.


WHEREAS, at the City Council meeting on January 16, 2003, the Albany City Council approved the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department in the amount of \$35,000 for the construction of a new playground at Takena Park; and

WHEREAS, conditions of obtaining this grant include a local match of 50 percent; and


WHEREAS, receipt of these funds will allow the City to install new playground equipment at Takena Park. This project includes the installation of two age-appropriate structures, one for children aged 2-5 years and another for children aged 5-12 years; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany accepts this Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department in the amount of \$35,000 for the construction of a new playground at Takena Park, approves the City of Albany local match of \$35,000, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the agreements and conditions for acceptance.
