RESOLUTION NO. 5019

A RESOLUTION TO ABANDON PROCEEDINGS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS INITIATED AS SS-03-03, CLEVELAND STREET SEWER EXTENSION LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (LID).

WHEREAS, on July 7, 2003, a health hazard was declared by the Linn County Department of Health Services for properties located at 416, 418, and 420 Cleveland Street; and

WHEREAS, Council initiated this LID project in response to and to resolve the health hazard by adopting Resolution No. 4883, directing staff to prepare an Engineer's Report and Financial Investigation; and

WHEREAS, an Initial Engineer's Report and Financial Investigation were accepted by Council and a public hearing was scheduled through adoption of Resolution No. 4893; and

WHEREAS, the property owners alternatively constructed the needed sanitary sewer line through the City's Site Improvement process under project number SI-03-13, Cleveland Street Sewer; and

WHEREAS, the sanitary sewer line has been accepted and is available for use; and

WHEREAS, Section 15.04.180 of the Albany Municipal Code requires the City Council to abandon Local Improvement District proceedings after they have been initiated.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council is abandoning proceeding related to the sanitary sewer improvements initiated as project SS-03-03, Cleveland Sanitary Sewer Extension LID, to be in accordance with AMC Section 15.04.180.
