A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AWARD OF THE 2004 LOCAL LAW ENFORCMENT BLOCK GRANT (LLEBG) FUNDS AND A COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Justice Assistance, of the U.S. Department of Justice, makes grants available through their Local Law Enforcement Block Grants Program; and
