- 3. The Grantor does hereby covenant with City of Albany that Grantor is lawfully seized and possessed of the real property above described, has a good and lawful right to convey it or any part thereof.
- 4. Upon performing any maintenance, City of Albany will make reasonable efforts to return the site to its original condition.
- 5. No permanent structure shall be constructed on this easement.
- 6. Unless an emergency repairs or maintenance is deemed to exist by City of Albany, during exercise of any rights conveyed by this easement City of Albany shall not unreasonably impede the ingress and egress of others.


