A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ALBANY TO OFFER A WATER BILL CREDIT FOR CUSTOMER PARTICIPATION IN A WATER SAMPLING PROGRAM TO TEST FOR LEAD AND COPPER.

WHEREAS, the Albany-Millersburg Joint Water Treatment Plant began water production in the fall of 2005; and

WHEREAS, because of this new water source, the Oregon Health Division is requiring additional water testing for lead and copper; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to take a minimum of 60 samples in June 2006 and another 60 samples in December 2006 from homes constructed in the early to mid 1980s, using samples from the same homes for both the June and December dates; and

WHEREAS, to encourage customers to participate in the water sampling program, the City will implement a \$10.00 credit towards the water bills of the customers who participate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council approves of a \$10.00 water bill credit for those customers who participate in the water sampling program required by the Oregon Health Division.
