RESOLUTION NO. 5305

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE OREGON STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE (05-658).

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has established a historic preservation program that includes public education, assistance, survey and inventory, and regulatory components; and

WHEREAS, the City would like to continue a matching grant program for rehabilitation projects for residential properties listed in the National Register; and

WHEREAS, the Carnegie Library Foundation Board has requested that the City apply for grant funds on their behalf to help fund the replacement of the front doors to the library with historically appropriate doors; and

WHEREAS, the City would like to hire a consultant to work on a potential expansion of the Monteith National Register Historic District boundary; and

WHEREAS, the City has annually applied for, and has been awarded, grant funds from the State Historic Preservation Office to assist in Albany's preservation program; and

WHEREAS, the required local match of 50 percent consists of the following: in-kind staff time by a planner who spends a portion of her time overseeing the preservation program, project rehabilitation money from residents awarded matching grants, and funds from the Carnegie Library Foundation and Monteith Historical Society.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that it does hereby accept this Certified Local Government Grant in the amount of \$19,900 from the State of Oregon Historic Preservation Office, Parks and Recreation Department, to be used for continuing a Certified Local Government program that includes review of historic alterations, public education, preservation planning, a residential rehabilitation grant program, and new front doors to the Downtown Carnegie Library.
