A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ACCEPTANCE OF OVERTIME REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE LINN COUNTY SHERIFF/LINN DRUG TASK FORCE FOR POLICE OVERTIME.

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon Criminal Justice Services Division of the Oregon State Police has distributed non-federal emergency grant funds to the Linn County Sheriff/Linn Drug Task Force for methamphetamine investigations and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany Police Department has been invited and approved to receive \$3,700 in overtime reimbursement and

WHEREAS, grant participation will disrupt illegal manufacture and trafficking of methamphetamine; and

WHEREAS, grant acceptance will require the funds be spent on methamphetamine investigation overtime expenses; and

WHEREAS, Oregon Local Budget Law provides that expenditures in the year of receipt of grants, gifts, bequests or devices transferred to the local government in trust for a specific purpose may be made after enactment of a resolution or ordinance authorizing the expenditure (ORS 294.326(3)).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council does hereby state that methamphetamine enforcement is a priority; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Albany City Council authorizes the Albany Police Department to accept overtime reimbursement from the Linn County Sheriff/Linn Drug Task Force for up to \$3,700 to be hereby appropriated as follows:
