A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ACCEPTANCE OF OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) GRANT FUNDS TO PURCHASE TWO MPH BEE III RADAR SPEED MEASUREMENT DEVICES IN FISCALYEAR 2009-2010.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation makes federal grant funds available to reimburse for the purchase of speed measurement equipment to law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany Police Department has been invited and approved to receive \$4,000 to reimburse for two (2) MPH Bee III Radars valued at \$5,300; and

WHEREAS, grant acceptance is required in Fiscal Year 2008-2009; and

WHEREAS, grant acceptance will add new speed measurement equipment not specifically budgeted for in F.Y. 2009-2010; and
