A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR UP TO \$1.5 MILLION FOR SEISMIC REHABILITATION OF FIRE STATION 12 THROUGH THE OREGON EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SEISMIC REHABILITATION GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, Albany's Fire Station 12 does not meet seismic standards as an emergency services facility; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany Strategic Plan for FY 2010 through FY 2014 identifies in Objective 10.13 seismic and remodeling upgrades to Fire Station 12; and

WHEREAS, Oregon Emergency Management has a Seismic Rehabilitation Grant Program that allows applications for up to \$1.5 million for seismic rehabilitation of critical public buildings; and

WHEREAS, grant applications may receive additional consideration if the applying agency can commit matching funds toward the seismic rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the City has a Capital Replacement Fund for City facilities; and

WHEREAS, the deadline for application to the Oregon Emergency Management Seismic Rehabilitation Grant is November 16, 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Albany City Council authorizes the Fire Department to apply for up to \$1.5 million for the seismic rehabilitation of Fire Station 12 from the Oregon Emergency Management Seismic Rehabilitation Grant Program and provide matching funds up to \$100,000.
