A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MULTIPLE APPLICATIONS TO THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, PUBLIC TRANSIT DIVISION FOR THE 2009-2011 JOBS AND TRANSPORTATION AND SPECIAL TRANSPORTATION OPERATIONS GRANTS FOR TRANSIT TO REPLACE ONE SEDAN WITH A WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE MINIVAN, PURHCASE AN EXPANSION WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE MINIVAN, PURCHASE BENCHES FOR BUS STOPS, REHABILITATE AN EXISTING LINN BENTON LOOP BUS, AND RECEIVE OPERATING FUNDS TO EXPAND THE ALBANY TRANSIT SERVICE AREA WITHIN EXISTING OPERATING HOURS.

WHEREAS, Albany Transit System, Albany Call-a-Ride, and the Linn-Benton Loop are qualified to provide public transportation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany is the governing body for the public transit systems; and

WHEREAS, Oregon Local Budget Law provides that expenditures in the year of receipt of grants, gifts, bequests, or devices transferred to the government in trust for a specific purpose may be made after enactment of a resolution or ordinance authorizing the expenditure (ORS 294,362(3)).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council authorizes staff to apply to the Oregon Department of Transportation for JTA and STO 2009-2011 grants to provide funding for vehicle purchases, purchase of benches for bus stops, a bus rehabilitation, and operating funding for expanded service area within existing service hours.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Albany City Council authorizes the Public Works Director to sign the applications on behalf of the city.
