TOPIC	DISCUSSION	DECISION / CONCLUSION
Call to Order		The meeting was called to order at 3:01 pm by the Chair, Hal Bruner.
2. Agenda Review	Chair Brauner asked if there were any additions or corrections to the agenda.	There were no changes to the agenda.
3. Public Comment		There were no public comments.
4. Minutes of August 29, 2017 meeting	Ali stated that CAMPO only receives 5303 FHWA funds, and this needs to be corrected in the minutes. There were no other corrections noted.	Consensus by the Loop Board to approve the August 29, 2017 meeting minutes with correction.
5. Loop Scope Service Analysis Update	Lee Lazaro provided an update on the Loop Scope of Work (SOW). Lazaro noted that the TAC has previously submitted a memo on why it was important to do the Plan. Since then, a sub group of the TAC drafted revised SOW. At its last meeting, the full TAC reviewed the draft and made additional edits. Those have	Consensus from the Board to proceed as follows: • Work with ODOT to amend the consultant's

been incorporated and the Board received those via email the day prior to this meeting.

Lazaro stated that the SOW prioritizes establishing a route and schedule (service) plan to best serve the region, including OSU, LBCC, rural areas, the two MPO's, and major employers such as Hewlett Packard, Samaritan, and CH2M Hill.

Additionally, the SOW needs to be a practical analysis that is in place and ready for HB 2017 funding, Lazaro said. The Plan should specifically emphasize low-income populations, and helping people get to employment and education.

Chair Brauner questioned if there would be studies of spikes / spurs off of the Loop that would connect to neighboring transit points such as the Corvallis Airport, and Amtrak station. Commissioner Nyquist stated that we would need to figure out what and where those points are, and alignment with other transit services such as the Linn Shuttle, ATS, and CTS.

Commissioner Nyquist questioned if the plan is to do "data crunching" on utilization projections. Staff, Phil Warnock noted that there are technical aspects of the Loop that differ from the city transit systems. The Plan needs to be designed in a way that it maintains express or commuter type of service while optimizing connectivity to companion systems. In HB 2017 there will be intercity connectivity funds as well, so this is a good position for a variety of funding streams and options of how it coordinates. To Chair Brauner's question, Warnock advised that spurs to the Loop service have been a consideration. Examples of short, medium, and long term improvements would be taken into consideration;

- contract for the Albany RTP and TDP (DKS, the consultant, and Nelson/Nygaard, subcontractor) for inclusion of the Loop Plan as an extension of the contract

the Albany TDP follows a similar structure with regard to the timing of its recommendations.

City of Albany staff, Chris Bailey advised that the City has almost finalized its TDP. The TDP has a lot of growth data that can be used for the Loop SOW. Also included in the TDP are short, medium, and long term scenarios. There was a cursory look of the Loop with suggested changes for a medium term change.

SOW Funding Discussion

Lazaro stated that he presented a draft SOW to the CAMPO Policy Board at its most recent meeting. Terry Cole, ODOT, was present at that meeting and stated that he would assist in searching for funds through ODOT. Since then, at the last Loop TAC meeting, staff Tarah Campi suggested that the Albany RTP/TDP contract be amended to include the Loop SOW Plan in order to avoid a full RFP and save time, while utilizing the expertise of Nelson/Nygaard which has worked on both the Albany and Corvallis TDPs. The TAC supported the idea. Lazaro spoke with Cole in regards to the matter and Cole indicated ODOT is open to the amendment of the contract to include the Loop Plan as an extension. However, ODOT does not have any funds available to assist.

Lazaro went on to review funding scenario options provided to members via memo. These included ODOT remaining funds from regional plans, discretionary grant funds, capital bus funds, TGM grants, , and a \$30,000 contribution from CAMPO. The timeline did not align for most of these to work at this time. Another option the TAC discussed, at the previous direction of the Loop Board, was to ask for a planning contribution of \$6,400 from each of the

	following partners: CAMPO, OSU, LBCC, Linn County, and Benton County. The AAMPO has already allocated \$28,000 in its UPWP for this work. Another funding possibility is the Transportation and Growth Management (TGM). The issue with the TGM is that its funding cycle does not work for our purpose. Chair Brauner noted that the member contribution option offered the quickest and easiest way to proceed with the project. Commissioner Nyquist stated that knowing that some entities have not budgeted this money and need to wait for next year budget, Linn County is willing to expedite the Plan and contribute more than its share. He suggested to find out if a partner is not able to provide its share. He requested to receive as much information as possible to assist with making funding recommendations at the County level. Members reached consensus for staff to move forward with ODOT amending the City of Albany TDP to include the Loop Plan as an extension. They requested to receive an updated contract for review prior to moving forward with it. A conference call or electronic meeting may be called to order to move this forward as needed. The Cascades West COG is anticipated to be the fiscal agent or contractor for coordinating the Plan. Members also reached consensus to ask \$6,400 contribution to

Agreement (MOA)	Members received a draft MOA between the City of Albany and the Loop Board. Per the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) establishing the governance of the Linn-Benton Loop, the Board and the City will develop an MOA sufficient to formalize agreements between the City of Albany and the Loop Parties.	Staff will update the MOA with the Board's requests and forward to the City of Albany for final review of their staff and attorney.

	 The MOA was emailed to the City for review and edits. The City provided minor edits and has yet to have its attorney review the document. Members went on to review the MOA and made the following recommendations: State that the City is a recipient of Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and partner funds Add line under Section 3 in regards to Invoicing and Receiving partnership funds Use IGA termination language in MOA; remove reference to expiration date in 2018 The Board was agreed on the importance of authorizing the Chair to sign the MOA once an agreement has been reached and the MOA is finalized in order to speed up the process and not wait until the February 2018 Board meeting. 	Consensus from the Board for the Chair to sign the final Loop Memorandum of Agreement once finalized.
7. Budget and Ridership Reports	Bailey with the City of Albany provided a Budget and Ridership summary. She highlighted that two buses have been purchased and received. Partner contributions have yet to be invoiced. Fares are over 50% collected. It is possible that this is due to a change in ridership composition. Fare funds are of those riders who are not students. Additionally, Bailey noted that ridership remains fairly steady over last year. OSU ridership has stayed the same while LBCC is slightly increased. Fuel and maintenance costs are doing fairly well so far. Warnock questioned where partnership funds are going. He noted that it wasn't clear on the report. Bailey stated that she was unsure and will check on that.	

	HB 2017 Discussion Warnock noted that HB 2017 has had two meetings into its	
	rules creation process for transit. The Committee is working on building consensus around legislative intent. He stated that Lee Lazaro, Mark Volmert, and Cynda Bruce have provided comments to the Committee.	
	Warnock went on to advise that there is a lot to discuss regarding how implementation should unfold. He noted that the increase in available funds will likely speed up the implementation of local plans.	
	Commissioner Nyquist questioned the payroll tax mechanism and if it will be based on where the person works, or where the person lives. Warnock stated that a comment was made that it would be where the person works. However, this is not resolved in draft language yet.	
	Warnock also discussed "qualified entities." The legislative language recognizes Transit Districts where they exist. Where there is no Transit District, such as in Benton and Linn counties, funds go to the County to be dispersed at their own discretion. The Rules Advisory Committee is still working through the specifics of these guidelines.
