Action: Council agreed that staff should try to work with individuals and neighborhoods on local solutions. There was not support for a designated “resident-only” parking permit program.
8. OFFER TO DONATE PRIVATE PROPERTY – Sean Kidd. [Verbal]
Action Requested: Council directed that staff work with the property owner’s attorney to accept the deed to the property and work with the bank to see what it would take to acquire the title.
9. CITY MANAGER SEARCH PROCESS – Wes Hare. [Verbal]
Action Requested: Council directed that staff start the process to select an executive search firm.
10. BUSINESS FROM THE COUNCIL
Council directed that staff bring back a change to AMC Chapter 6.10 to allow swine within the City limits with the following provisions: one-acre minimum; secure permission of neighbors within 300 feet; 25-foot setback from the property line; limit of two pigs for a four-month period, used for educational activity.
