## Why?

- Church preschool staff noticed waste.
- Nearest City porta-pot is inaccessible.
- Lack of restrooms creates health risk.

## Some clarifications:

- Not part of community meal service.
- Church unable to build a restroom.
- Not trying to solve homelessness.
- Goal is to work with the City.

### Why we're here

- January 18: Church learns from newspaper that City requires permission
- January 26: Church writes to City to request permission.
- February 8. City denies permission, suggests Church appeal to Council.
- February 19: Church writes to City asking to appeal to Council
- February 27: City says Church may not appeal, but ask at Public Business.
  - The City Manager worked with us to plan today's Session
  - We invited Mayor Konopa to meet us at Tuesday Meal.

### 1. Fix the Code.

- Amend the Municipal Code by ordinance.
- City Manager: the Council could establish objective criteria to grant/deny permission.
- This would solve two issues:
  - the toilet at FCC.
  - the City's collection of toilets.

### 2. Council: Form a Restroom Committee.

- The Code provides this option.
- Gather info and make recommendations:
  - Determine needs.
  - Balance costs and opportunities.
  - Propose solutions.
