**Develop viable urban communities principally to benefit low- and moderate-income residents and neighborhoods**

# 2021 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

## ☐ Prevent and Respond to COVID-19:

- Community LendingWorks provided 13 emergency business grants and 74 jobs were created or retained as a result
- Community Services Consortium provided emergency housing assistance to 3 households
- YMCA, Boys and Girls Club and Family Tree Relief Nursery provided childcare, youth services and family support to 128 individuals

## ☐ Reduce Homelessness:

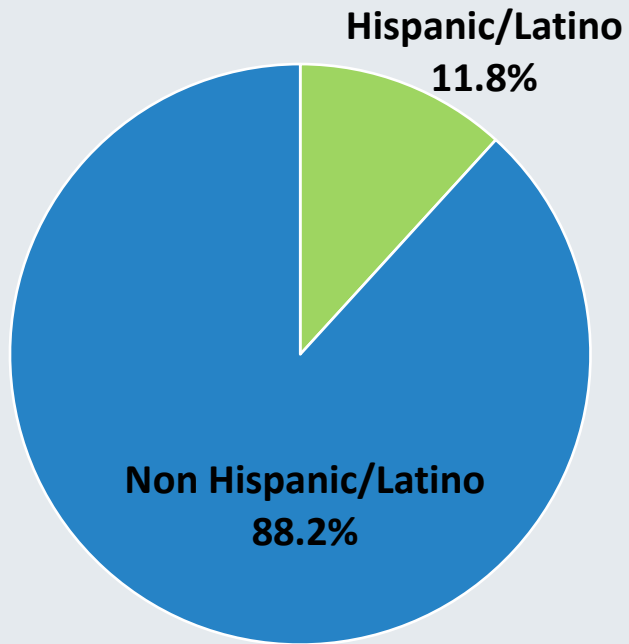
- Two shelters improved and repaired their facilities and provided 366 individuals with higher quality shelter
  - Albany Helping Hands got a new roof
  - Second CHANCE repaired the failing HVAC system
- Jackson Street Youth Services provided shelter for 26 youth

# 2021 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

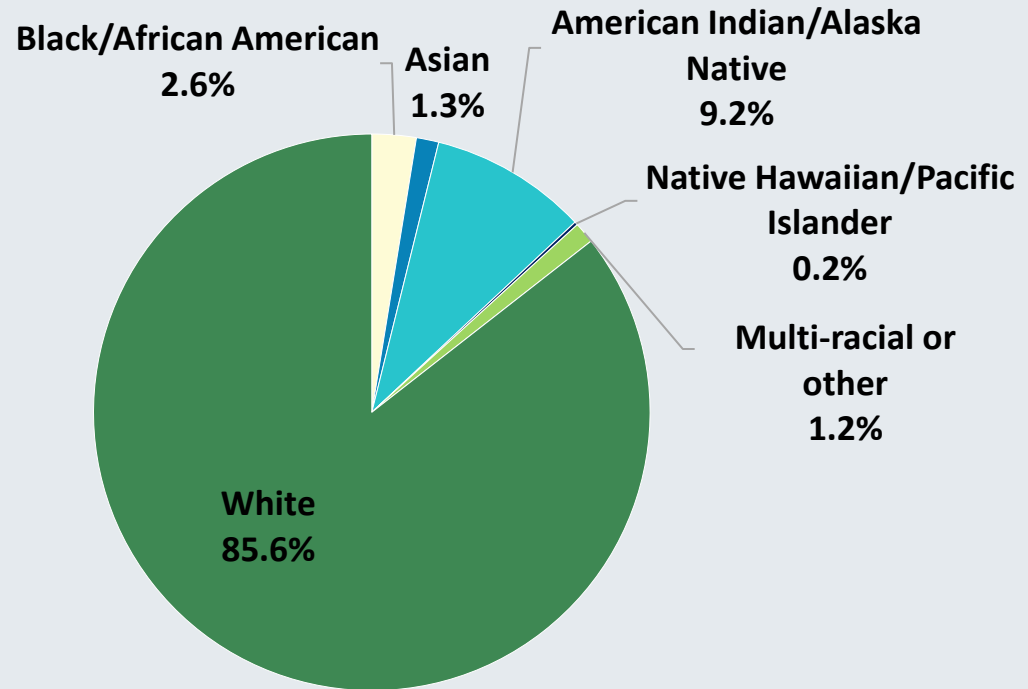
- ❑ **Child Abuse Prevention** – Family Tree Relief Nursery supported high risk families with childcare, in-home visits, and referrals to resources benefitting 89 individuals
- ❑ **Senior Companion Program** – Oregon Cascades West Council of Governments ensured 17 low-income seniors received services from companions
- ❑ **Food boxes, beds, furniture** – Furniture Share served 1,952 individuals
  - 745 beds to kids
  - 108 dining room tables
  - 882 individuals received furniture or household items
  - 1,952 individuals received food boxes
- ❑ **Preserve Affordable Housing** – DevNW completed 3 housing rehab loan projects
- ❑ **Fair Housing Training** – collaborated with the City of Corvallis to offer 2 Fair Housing Trainings
