



1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 3:35 p.m.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

MOTION: Oscar Hult moved to approve the December 11, 2012 minutes as presented. Linda Herd seconded the motion, and it **passed** 6-0.

4. INTRODUCTION OF NEW MEMBER

Margaret (Peggy) Kroessin was introduced, and provided some background information to the Commission.

5. DISCUSSION ITEMS

a. Co-op

Linda Herd and Melissa Babcock Saylor met with Marc Manley regarding the space currently being used for the Phantom Gallery. Manley is advertising the rental space at \$2,750 per month. Billie Moore noted that approximately 15 artists are interested in membership at \$50 per month, but that still does not reach the figure Manley is looking for. Brief discussion followed.

ACTION ITEMS:

- Billie will check with Cheryl French regarding the legal issues for establishing the Co-op.

b. Albany Story - themes that can be used for creating public art.

Ed provided background on the project for Peggy.

Chuck Leland met with Kay Burk of Albany Regional Museum, and Edward Loy, author of "*Tim Burr*," who is currently writing a book on the history of Albany. The tentative publish date for the

book is the end of 2013. In addition, the museum is looking into creating a plaque in tribute to Samuel Simpson, Oregon's first poet laureate, which would tie into the Albany Story project.

c. Artist Social

The social will be held on February 12, 2013 in the Council Chambers at City Hall. The social will be advertised from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m.
