1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 3:30 p.m.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

MOTION: Lynn Whitacre moved to approve the October 8, 2013 minutes as presented. Linda Herd seconded the motion, and it **passed** 5-0.

3. BUSINESS FROM THE PUBLIC

4. DISCUSSION ITEMS

a. Going to Pots

Going to Pots was held October 17-19, 2013. The event went better than last year; the Arts Commission portion of the sales was \$954.00.; minus expenses, the Commission netted \$716.00. Brief discussion followed.

b. Display Schedule-City Hall

The application and jury process was reviewed. Billie asked for clarification regarding an application for a group show. Consistent with policy, the application needs to have an accurate representation of the proposed show, with at least one sample from each artist submitted with the application. Brief discussion followed.

Billie has been in touch with a group from Lebanon that is interested in displaying "Chainsaw Art". Ed noted City Hall can accommodate 3D pieces, but security or barriers would be the responsibility of the Artist.

6. EXHIBITS

Kate McGee submitted an application for the Purely Pastel Artist to display at City Hall.

MOTION: Chuck Leland moved to accept the Purely Pastel Artist's application to display in City Hall. Linda Herd seconded the motion, and it **passed** 5-0.

Jacqueline Peterson has submitted an application to display at City Hall.

Her application was not accepted at this time. Billie will follow up to find out more about her pieces, and what other mediums she uses.

Ed noted the volume of applications being received has increased, and includes a number of applicants outside of Albany. In the future, the Commission may need to review and draft policy outlining the process for prioritizing artist's applications for the schedule.

7. BUSINESS FROM THE COMMISSION

a. Teen Art Show

A save-the-date email has gone out to the schools. The application packets will be distributed to the schools after winter break.

b. Public Art Project

Melissa inquired if Commissioners wanted to hold another retreat this fall, and about the idea of creating a public art program which was generated from the retreat last October. Ed suggested forming a group to focus on creating a public art program for the purpose of acquiring and displaying sculpture. Ed suggested John Boock, Jay Burcham, an Arts Commissioner, and himself as members of the group.

MOTION: Linda Herd moved to have Ed proceed in constructing a group focused on creating a public art program for the purpose of acquiring and displaying sculpture. Billie Moore seconded the motion, and it **passed** 5-0.

ACTION ITEMS:

- Ed will coordinate a meeting

c. Commission Positions

Chuck and Melissa's terms will be ending December 31, 2013. They will receive official notice from the City Manager's Office, and have the option of reapplying if they would like to continue as members of the Commission. Additionally, new officers will need to be elected after the first of the year.

PROSPECTUS FOR ALBANY TEEN ART SHOW

The Albany Teen Art show is open to all eight grade and high school aged teens residing in Albany, or attending school in Albany and residing elsewhere. We welcome participation by home and alternative schooled teens not attending public schools as well as those in public school.

Works may be two or three dimensional. Two dimensional works may consist of drawings, paintings, print making, fiber art, and collage. All works intended for hanging must be equipped with a secure hanging device. Fragile surfaces should be protected with glass or plastic. Three dimensional art may include jewelry, pottery, small sculpture and cabinetry. Sculpture and pottery must be stable for display on a horizontal surface. All works must be suitable for public display. Works deemed unsuitable will be rejected at the time of judging and the artist will be notified.

CONDITIONS:

- Each participant must complete a Teen Art Show form for each submission. Submissions are limited to three works per student.
- Submissions must not have been shown in a previous Albany Teen Art show.
- All art work must be clearly labeled with the artist's name, title, medium and price, or if not for sale, labeled NFS. Works without correct labels will not be eligible for judging.
- Work copied from other artwork is strongly discouraged. However if an artist wishes to enter a copy or interpretation of another's work, in all cases attribution to the original artist or photographer must be included on the entry form and painting label, regardless of the copyrighted status of the original work. Failure to credit the original artist may result in rejection of the entry.
- All prices indicated on the entry form or painting label may not be changed during the show.
- Paintings may be sold and so labeled during the course of the show. However the artist is encouraged to allow the work to remain on display for the duration of the show. Once submitted for judging the work may not be exchanged for a different work.
- By submission of work, artists grant permission to the City of Albany and the Albany Arts Commission to use the work or a facsimile for promotion of City art-related activities.
- Works must be delivered to Albany City Hall between 8:30am – 5:00 April 24th and 25th (Thursday & Friday) and 10:00am - noon April 26th (Saturday), 2014. No exceptions or late entries are allowed.
- Displayed work must be retrieved from May 29th through May 30th. Unclaimed works will be considered abandoned.

Art will be judged by members of the Albany Arts Commission the basis of originality, technical skill and the emergence of personal vision or voice.

Art will be on display at Albany City Hall during May 2014. A reception will be held May 8, 2014. 1ST, 2ND, 3rd cash prizes for two dimensional and three dimensional works will be presented, as well as certificates of honorable mention. The People's Choice award will be announced at the conclusion of the show.
