**CALL TO ORDER**

Irish called the meeting to order at 12:07 p.m.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Siddall made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 10, 2015, meeting, and Lawrence seconded the motion, and it passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

**NEW COMMISSIONER**

Tim McCloud introduced himself and provided some background.

Irish explained the role of the Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Commission. He explained it was a very self-directed group.

**CORVALLIS SPRING ROLL**

Irish explained about the Corvallis Spring Roll bicycle event and how Corvallis has quite a bit of community involvement in the event.

Irish agreed to email the Commission additional information on the start time of the Corvallis event. He will also talk to the supporters and see if they would be interested in attending a similar event in Albany.

**ODOT ARTS PROGRAM**

Irish discussed the All Roads Transportation Safety (ARTS) Program. Oregon Department of Transportation's (ODOT) new safety program addresses safety needs on all public roads in Oregon. It attempts to reduce crashes in high-crash locations (those sites with injury or fatalities). The locations Irish submitted on the City's application include Pacific and 9<sup>th</sup>, Pacific and Geary, and Queen and Geary. ODOT will finalize the award list in May.

*Note: Lawrence left the meeting at 12:50 p.m. At this time, there was no longer a quorum, but since the next discussion item did not require a vote, the meeting continued until 1:05 p.m.*

Irish discussed Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons at pedestrian crossings with the remaining Commissioners.
