

ORDINANCE NO. 5817

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A STREET NAME CHANGE FOR PUBLIC STREETS DEDICATED AND NAMED ON THE CLAIREWOOD, BENTON WOODS, AND BENTON WOODS PHASE II SUBDIVISION PLATS, IN BENTON COUNTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, public street rights-of-way were dedicated as a result of Benton County Survey No. SP0011-015, Benton County Survey No. SP0011-025, and Benton County Survey No. SP0011-027; and

WHEREAS, these Subdivision Plats identified the right-of-way as North Albany Road; and

WHEREAS, notices of public hearing were mailed on July 15, 2013; and published in the *Albany Democrat-Herald* on July 22, 2013; as required by ORS 227.120; and

WHEREAS, the Albany Planning Commission held a public hearing on July 29, 2013, to hear testimony regarding the street name change; and

WHEREAS, the Albany Planning Commission voted to recommend that the City Council approve the proposed street name change; and

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council held a public hearing on August 14, 2013, to hear testimony regarding the street name change; and,

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council has determined that the changing of this street name is in the best interest of the City of Albany, as required by ORS 227.120.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

The sections of North Albany Road NW dedicated on the above mentioned subdivision plats, and shown on Ordinance Exhibit A, are hereby changed to 23rd Avenue NW.

Emergency Declared. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of this city of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect when signed by the Mayor.
