BICYCLES
All buses are equipped with bicycle racks that hold two bikes. Access is first come, first served. No bikes are allowed on-board the buses. We cannot accommodate motorized or oversized bicycles. Bike lockers are available to rent by arrangement with Albany Transit staff. Call 541-917-7667 for more information.

Adults (age 18 and older)	\$30.00
Senior (age 60+) / Disabled / Youth (age 6-17)	\$15.00
Good for unlimited, non-continuous rides for one month. One, two, and three month passes are available for purchase. Perfect for frequent riders. Monthly passes are sold at Albany City Hall and at the Transit office at Albany Station.

Adults	\$17.00
Senior / Disabled / Youth	\$8.50
Single-ride tickets you can use anytime. Twenty rides per book. Coupon books are available at Albany City Hall and at the Transit office at Albany Station.

Transfers at designated transfer points between ATS buses are FREE.

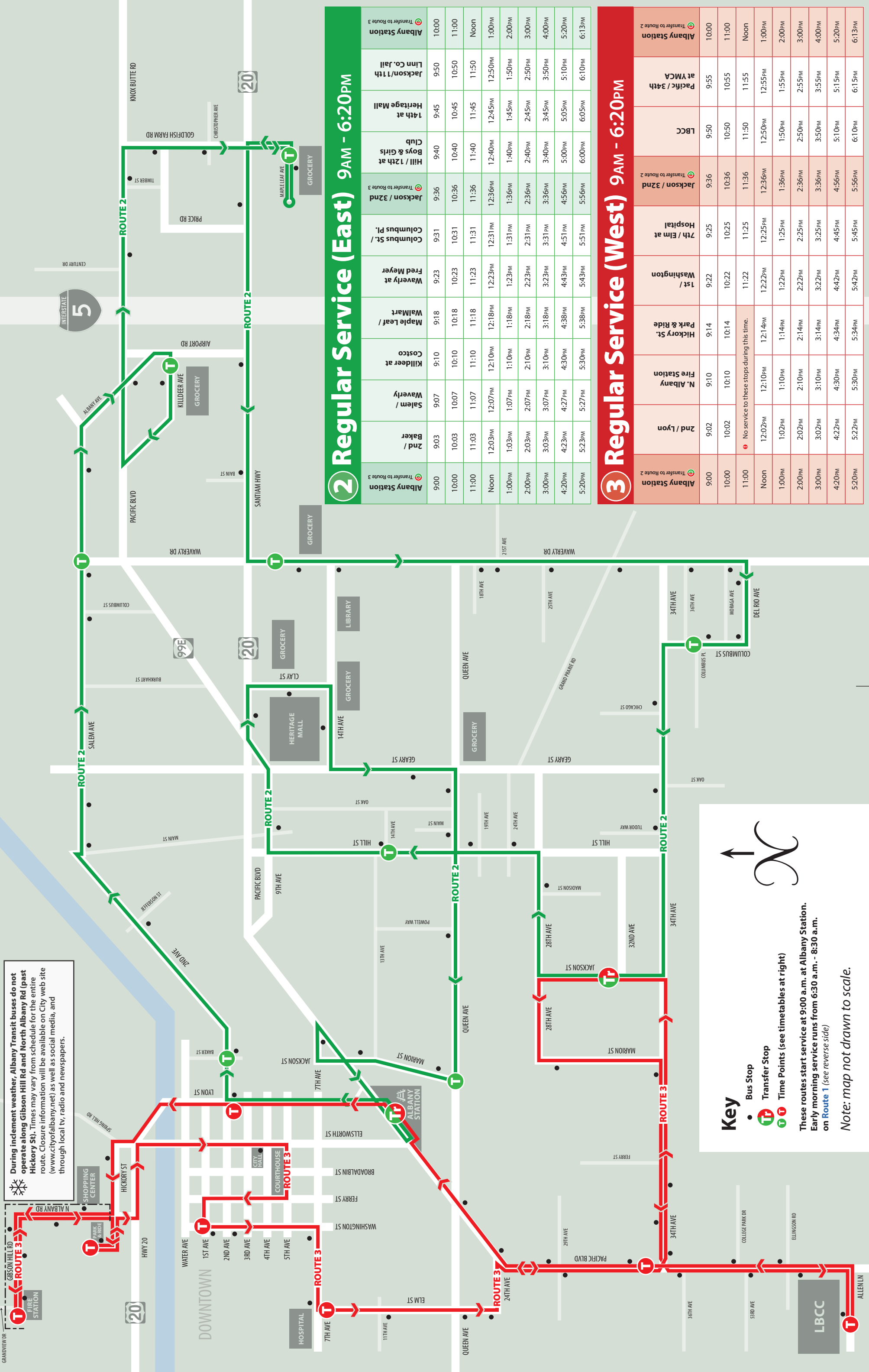
